

**TEXT AMENDMENT: City-initiated request to amend subsection 2-2.138 and 2-2.172 of the Unified Development Ordinance (UDO) to adjust the definitions for “Junked motor vehicle” and “Motor vehicle” and to approve Plan Consistency Resolution No. 2020-0004.**

The following is a City-initiated request to amend subsection 2-2.138 and 2-2.172 of the Unified Development Ordinance (UDO) to adjust the definitions for “Junked motor vehicle” and “Motor vehicle”. The proposed amendments would provide a mechanism to better enforce junked motor vehicles and boats.

**Article 2. Basic Definitions and Interpretations**

2-2 Definitions of Basic Terms

2-2.138 *Junked motor vehicle.* ~~As authorized and defined in G.S. 160A-303.2, the term, junked motor vehicle means a vehicle that does not display a current license plate lawfully upon that vehicle and~~ **A motor vehicle that:**

- (A) Is partially dismantled or wrecked; or
- (B) Cannot be self-propelled or moved in the manner in which it originally was intended to move; or
- (C) Is more than five (5) years old ~~and appears to be worth less than one hundred dollars (\$100.00)~~ **and worth less than five hundred dollars (\$500); or**
- (D) **Does not display a current license plate.**

2-2.172 *Motor vehicle or vehicle.* All machines designed or intended to travel over land **or water** by self-propulsion or while attached to any self-propelled vehicle.
