Councilmember Ballou moved **to enter into CLOSED SESSION** in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Building, 202 South 8th Street, Morehead City, N.C., during the Regular Meeting of the Council held on Tuesday, March 10, 2020, as per 143-318.11(a)(3) to consult with city attorney to consider and give instructions concerning a potential or actual claim, administrative procedure, or judicial action. Councilmember McCann seconded, and the motion carried unanimously. (5-0)

Mr. Eggleston offered to provide a copy of last year's evaluation and share the evaluation form electronically to aid in preparing this year's evaluation. Individual evaluations should be submitted by April 28, 2020 so that the final can be completed by the May 5, 2020 deadline.


SHEVANS PARK PROJECT

Mr. Eggleston reported that the bid bonds and performance bonds for the Shevans Park playground project were over-looked but both contractors have been instructed to and have agreed to submit the statutorily required bonds immediately.

Councilmember Taylor shared five aspects he would like included in all project presentations going forward: estimated total cost, capital impact, impact on operating expense budget, bid and/or purchasing process, and funding details.

Councilmember Horton addressed the Manager and other Councilmembers with his legal concerns related to his unanswered request for public documents related to the Shevans Park matter and other topics. Mr. Eggleston responded stating that he had provided all available documentation requested with the exception of the stormwaster documentation provided today, and suggested that the misunderstanding may be a matter of perspective or interpretation. Mr. Eggleston further stated that every effort would be made to respond to future requests more expeditiously.

Councilmember Warrender moved **to return to OPEN SESSION at 8:31 p.m.** Councilmember Taylor seconded and the motion carried unanimously. (5-0)
